

Assignment 2 – 100 points

Objective:

To learn how to link document, images, create a navigation system, use the iframe element.

How to Submit:

You must submit this assignment on Blackboard using the assignment tool. The files needed are in a folder. You will zip this folder and name it assignment2.zip and submit it on Blackboard.

Requirements:

You can add content to the pages, but you must keep the original content. Place your name inside an HTML comment after the <!doctype> in each html file.

You are free to use your own judgment and preferences. You are given the files and you need to add code to them as per instructions. See video - <https://youtu.be/0Gi3Vq3UAro>

You must have the below requirements:

- Two thumbnail images are correctly coded into the home page and correctly linked to the respective web page **20 points**
 - The above two web pages have a larger image inserted on them correctly **5 points**
 - All web pages have the same navigation and that navigation contains correct links to all of the pages **20 points**
 - A link is created at the bottom of the home page that takes you to the top of the home page and it is coded correctly **10 points**
 - The “Photos” page contain three thumbnail images. When these images are clicked, they open into an iframe element on the same page. Therefore, an iframe HTML page must be created to begin with. **25 points**
 - Correct HTML usage (semantics) and syntax **10 points**
 - **Nice consistent code layout** **10 points**

Helpful Hints

Link to a fragment identifier

```
<element id="some_value"> </element>
```

```
<a href="#some_value">click</a>
```


Create an iframe

```
<iframe id="some_value" name="some_value" width="some_value"  
height="some_value"> </iframe>
```

Note that the name attribute uniquely identifies the iframe, as does the id attribute. You need both attributes and they both need to have the same value.


Target a file into an iframe

```
<a href="file_name" target="iframe_name_attribute_value">click</a>
```
