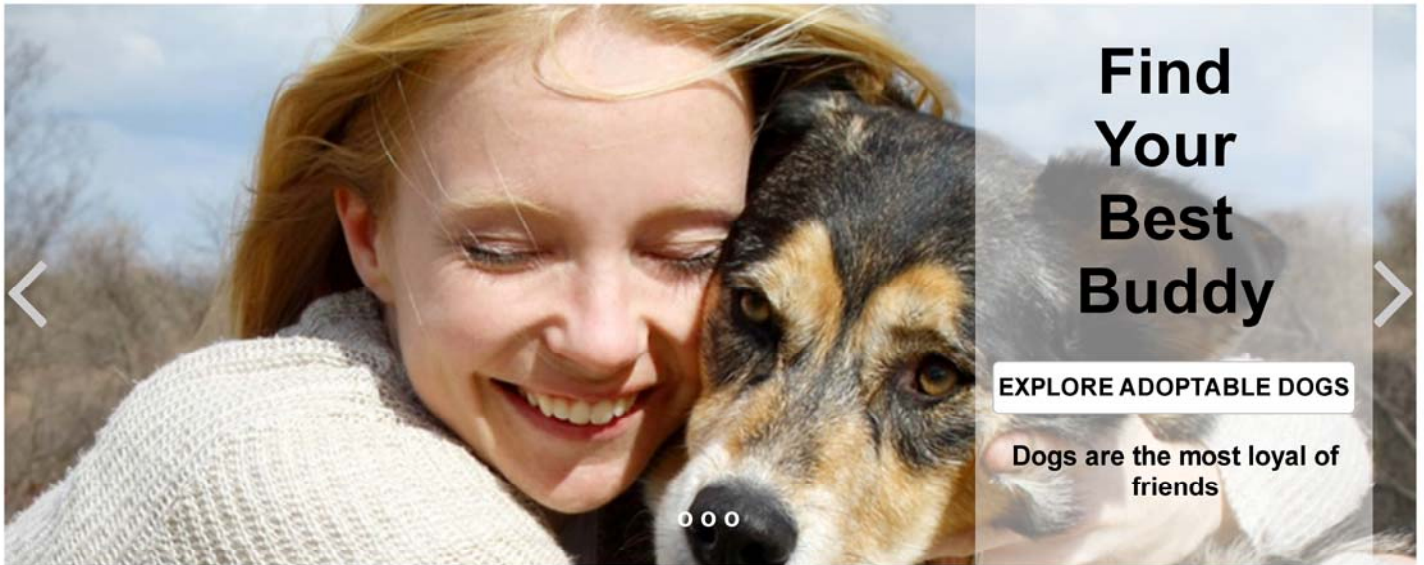

1. Volunteer Acknowledgement and Participation.

I acknowledge that I have voluntarily agreed to serve as a volunteer for Fort Irwin Humane Society, Inc., ("FIHS") a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of California, whose mission is: To provide safe harbor, medical care and love for adoptable dogs that have been abused, abandoned and neglected until they are placed into loving, responsible permanent homes; to decrease the need for senseless destroying of dogs by educating the public about the benefits of spaying and neutering; to build a community where people value animals and treat them with respect and kindness; to promote respect for life, responsible pet ownership and to encourage the higher ideals of compassion toward animals and people through education and example.

2. **Nature and Scope of Services.** As a Volunteer I will be contributing my time and effort to various services for FIHS. The services will be performed by me as assigned by an officer, director of another volunteer of FIHS. In the course of performing the services, I agree:

- ☐ To read the Volunteer handbook (if applicable) and complete all required training, orientation and paperwork relating to my volunteer position.
- ☐ To disclose any physical or psychological limitations to appropriate directors or officers before participating in any activity. 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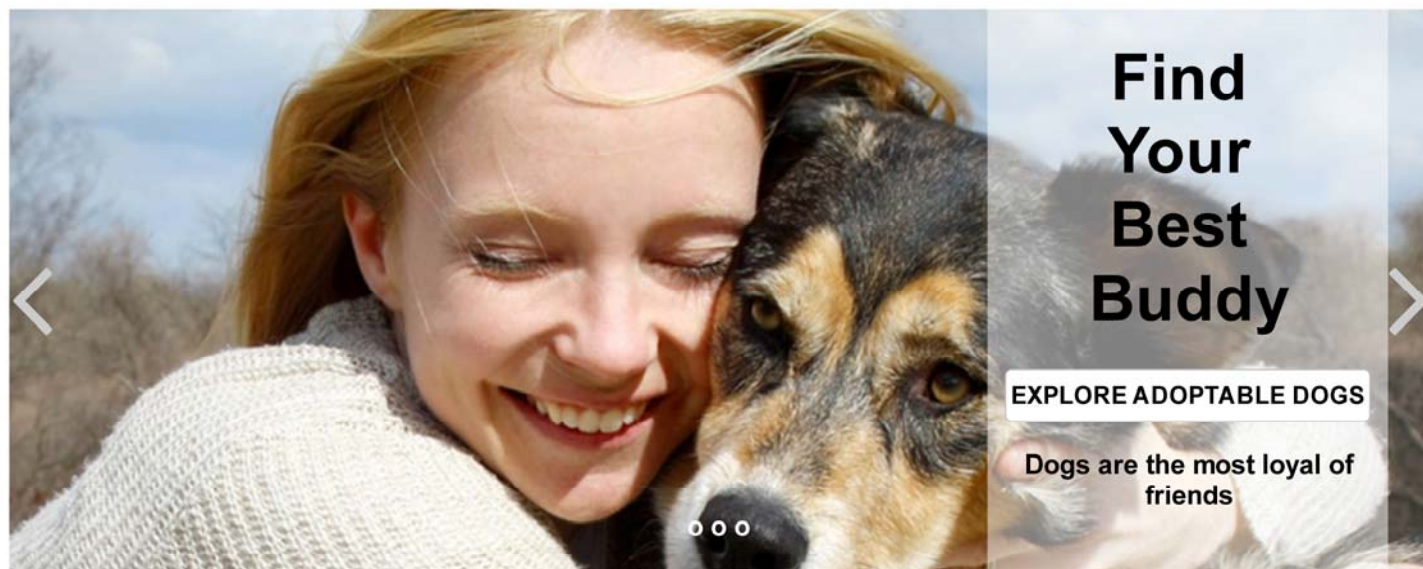
